Candidates will be selected strictly on the merit basis (percentage/marks of essential qualification). Only Selected candidates will be informed through offer letter.

Enrollment under Apprentice Act 1961: It is mandatory for candidates to enroll themselves on National Apprenticeship Training Scheme (NATS) portal (<http://portal.mhrdnats.gov.in>) before applying for apprenticeship training.

Candidates who have already undergone apprenticeship training in any institute/organisation are not eligible and only those who have passed out in 2018 or later can only apply. A certificate in this regard may be furnished.

It may be explicitly understood that subsequent to the training period, DRDO shall not offer any employment in the organisation.
